Senate Bill 449 (Senator Bromwell)

Finance

Treasurer - Custodian - Injured Workers' Insurance Fund

This bill authorizes, rather than requires, the Treasurer to serve as custodian of the Injured Workers' Insurance Fund (IWIF).

Fiscal Summary

State Effect: None. The bill codifies existing practice. IWIF's board has, for several years, served as IWIF's custodian and would continue to do so pursuant to this bill.

Local Effect: None.

Small Business Effect: None.

Analysis

Current Law: The Treasurer is required to serve as IWIF's custodian. IWIF's board is required to pay all of IWIF's expenses, including losses on insurance. Excess funds may be invested in investments authorized for insurers or deposited in accordance with the laws governing the deposits of State money.
