Federal Constitutional Amendment - Judicial Taxation

This joint resolution memorializes the United States Congress to propose and submit to the several states for ratification no later than January 1, 2001, an amendment to the Constitution of the United States providing that no federal court shall have the power to levy or increase taxes. The joint resolution also calls upon the members of the Maryland Congressional Delegation to utilize their resources and influence to ensure passage of such an amendment to the United States Constitution.
