## AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL NO. 150, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill - Committee Reprint)

On page 254, after line 13 insert:

"SECTION 50. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That in the the Division of Neighborhood Revitalization of the Department of Housing and Community Development, \$10,000,000 in general funds appropriated to program SA24.02, Neighborhood Business Development -- Capital Appropriation, for the Community Legacy Program and in the Department of Natural Resources, \$50,000,000 in general funds appropriated to program KA05.10, Outdoor Recreation Land Loan, for the GreenPrint and Community Parks and Playground programs, may not be expended until the Governor develops a revised fiscal 2002 Capital Improvement Program that increases by \$187,000,000 the planned school construction funding for fiscal 2002 through 2005 and submits the revised Capital Improvement Plan to the Legislative Policy Committee for review and comment. The Legislative Policy Committee shall have 45 days to review and comment upon the revised Capital Improvement Program prior to the expenditure of funds."

On page 254, in Committee Amendment No. 276, in line 14 strike "<u>50.</u>" and substitute "<u>51.</u>"; and in line 21, strike "<u>51.</u>" and substitute "<u>52.</u>".

Explanation: The fiscal 2001 Capital Improvement Program included planned school construction funding of \$744.8 million for fiscal 2002 through 2005. The fiscal 2002 Capital Improvement Program includes only \$557.8 million in planned school construction funding for fiscal 2002 through 2005, \$187 million less than the previous year's plan. This amendment would withhold funding for the GreenPrint, Community Parks and Playgrounds, and Community Legacy programs until the Governor revises the fiscal 2002 Capital Improvement Plan to include an additional \$187 million for school construction and submits the plan to the Legislative Policy Committee for review and comment.
