# AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike "Senator Stoltzfus" and substitute "Senators Stoltzfus and Frosh".

### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 4, after "purposes;" insert "<u>authorizing the Department to consult with the State Plumbing Board on certain matters;</u>"; and strike beginning with "providing" in line 5 down through "purposes" in line 7 and substitute "<u>authorizing the Department to establish certain buffer and setback requirements for the use of reclaimed water for irrigation purposes</u>".

### AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 16, after "(c)" insert "(1)"; and after line 18, insert:

"(2) THE DEPARTMENT MAY CONSULT WITH THE STATE PLUMBING BOARD, AS APPROPRIATE, ON MATTERS RELATING TO THE OBJECTIVES OF SUBSECTION (B)(5) OF THIS SECTION.".

### AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 3, strike in their entirety lines 30 through 32, inclusive, and substitute:

- "(C) THE DEPARTMENT MAY ESTABLISH BUFFER AND SETBACK REQUIREMENTS FOR THE USE OF RECLAIMED WATER UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION AS FOLLOWS:
- (1) FROM POTABLE WELLS AND SURFACE WATER INTAKES, UP TO 100 FEET;
