AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 791, AS AMENDED

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments (HB0791/535469/5), strike Amendment No. 2 in its entirety.

On page 1 of the bill, in the sponsor line, strike “Delegate Taylor” and substitute “Delegates Taylor, McIntosh, Amedori, Baldwin, Branch, Brinkley, Bobo, Boschert, Boutin, Bronrott, DeCarlo, Donoghue, Doory, Dypski, Elliott, Getty, Gladden, Glassman, Goldwater, Greenip, Hixson, Howard, Hubers, Kittleman, Leopold, Menes, Parrott, Pitkin, Ports, Riley, Rosenberg, Turner, Stocksdale, and Stull”; in line 2, strike “Firearms Accident Prevention Program” and substitute “Firearms Safety and Accident Prevention Education Program”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “State” in line 11 and substitute “requiring each county board of education to develop and implement a certain firearms safety and accident prevention education program or hunter safety program for certain grades; authorizing a county board to implement the program in conjunction with certain entities; prohibiting the display or handling of ammunition or firearms in certain programs under certain circumstances; authorizing the display or handling of ammunition or firearms in certain programs under certain circumstances; and generally relating to the firearms safety and accident prevention education program”; and strike in their entirety lines 12 through 16, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments, strike Amendment No. 4 in its entirety.

On pages 2 and 3 of the bill, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 34 on page 2 through line 14 on page 3, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments, in line 3 of Amendment

(Over)

No. 5, before “OR” insert “EDUCATION”; in the same line, after “SAFETY” insert “EDUCATION”; and in lines 4 and 5, strike “POLICY AND GUIDELINES” and substitute ““EDDIE EAGLE GUNSAFE PROGRAM”, THE “IN A FLASH” PROGRAM, AND THE “STAR” PROGRAM, AND THAT:

(1) FOR STUDENTS IN KINDERGARTEN THROUGH GRADE 6, ADDRESSES FIREARM SAFETY AND ACCIDENT PREVENTION; AND

(2) FOR STUDENTS IN GRADE 7 THROUGH GRADE 12, ADDRESSES FIREARM SAFETY AND ACCIDENT PREVENTION OR HUNTER SAFETY OR BOTH”.

On page 3 of the bill, in lines 17 and 18, strike “ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE BOARD UNDER § 2-205(H)(4) OF THIS ARTICLE”.
