AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 731

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Cadden” and substitute “, Cadden, Donoghue, Harrison, and Hurson”; in line 7, after “license;” insert “requiring the Board to credit a certain fee toward a certain initial license fee;”; and in line 11, after “5-101(g)” insert “and 5-205(b)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, after line 5, insert:

“5-205.

(b) (1) Subject to paragraph (4) of this subsection, the Board shall establish reasonable fees for examinations, reinstatements, certifications, applications, preopening inspections, per diem fees for Board members, compensation for inspectors appointed by the Board, and for any other service performed by the Board necessary to carry out the provisions of this title.

(2) Except for the examination fees which the Board shall establish in amounts not to exceed the costs of the examinations, the fees established by the Board shall be set in a manner that will produce funds sufficient to cover the actual direct and indirect costs of regulating the cosmetology industry in the State in accordance with the provisions of this title.

(3) The total cost of regulating the cosmetology industry in the State in accordance with the provisions of this title may not be more than the revenues generated by the fees established under paragraph (1) of this subsection.

(4) [The] SUBJECT TO § 5-318(F) OF THIS TITLE, THE Board shall require a \$25 fee for the licensure or renewal of licensure of cosmetologists, senior cosmetologists, estheticians, nail technicians, and makeup artists.”;

(Over)

strike beginning with “ESTABLISHED” in line 16 down through “TITLE” in line 17 and substitute “OF \$10”; and after line 31, insert:

“(F) THE BOARD SHALL CREDIT THE AMOUNT OF THE APPLICATION FEE PAID BY AN APPLICANT UNDER THIS SECTION TOWARD THE INITIAL LICENSE FEE REQUIRED OF THE APPLICANT UNDER § 5-205(B) OF THIS TITLE.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 21, after “LICENSED” insert “SENIOR”; and in line 31, strike “OR A LIMITED LICENSE”.
