AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments (HB0791/535469/5), in line 6 of Amendment No. 2, after "<u>Firearms</u>" insert "<u>and Pedestrian</u>"; in the same line, strike "<u>Programs</u>" and substitute "<u>Programs</u>"; in line 7, strike "<u>a</u>"; in lines 7 and 13, before "<u>safety</u>" insert "<u>and pedestrian</u>"; and in line 14, strike "<u>programs</u>" and substitute "<u>programs</u>".

On page 1 of the bill, in lines 4 and 7, in each instance, strike "program" and substitute "programs"; and in line 19, after "7-411.1" insert "and 7-411.2".

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1 of the bill in line 24, after "accidents" insert "and pedestrian accidents"; and after line 26, insert:

"WHEREAS, It is necessary to teach children of the dangers of crossing the street and how to properly and safely use sidewalks and crosswalks; and".

On page 1 of the Committee on Ways and Means Amendments (HB0791/535469/5), in line 4 of Amendment No. 3, after "accidents" insert "and pedestrian accidents"; and after line 4, insert:

"WHEREAS, A curriculum can be developed to teach children the proper and safe use of sidewalks and crosswalks; and".

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3 of the bill, before line 15, insert:

and before line 24, insert:

"<u>7-411.2</u>

- (A) EACH COUNTY BOARD SHALL DEVELOP AND IMPLEMENT A PROGRAM OF INSTRUCTION FOR PEDESTRIAN SAFETY AND ACCIDENT PREVENTION THAT IS APPROPRIATE FOR THE STUDENTS IN ITS PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND THAT IS CONSISTENT WITH THE POLICY AND GUIDELINES ESTABLISHED BY THE STATE BOARD UNDER § 2-205(H)(5) OF THIS ARTICLE.
- (B) A COUNTY BOARD MAY IMPLEMENT THE PROGRAM IN CONJUNCTION WITH A STATE OR LOCAL LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY, ANOTHER ENTITY OF STATE OR LOCAL GOVERNMENT, OR A COMMUNITY OR CIVIC ORGANIZATION.".
