AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1311

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 5, after “of” insert “providing for the”; in the same line, after “redistricting” insert “of”; in line 6, strike “to reduce the number of districts” and substitute “in a certain manner, including the preparation of a certain alternative redistricting plan and presentation of redistricting plans to the Senate and House delegations of Prince George’s County to the General Assembly”; strike beginning with “restructuring” in line 6 down through “districts;” in line 9; strike beginning with “providing” in line 15 down through “Board;” in line 17; strike beginning with “providing” in line 18 down through “date” in line 19 and substitute “providing for the termination of this Act”; and in line 20, before “membership” insert “districts and”.

On page 2, in line 4, after “repealing” insert “and reenacting, with amendments,”; in line 6, strike “3-1001” and substitute “3-1001(k)”; strike in their entirety lines 9 through 13, inclusive; and strike in their entirety lines 19 through 28, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On pages 2 and 3, strike beginning with “Section(s)” in line 36 on page 2 down through “That” in line 3 on page 3.

On pages 3 and 4, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 6 on page 3 through line 11 on page 4, inclusive.

On pages 7 through 9, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 26 on page 7 through line 5 on page 9, inclusive, and substitute:

“(k) (1) Beginning in 1981, there shall be a redistricting every 10 years based on the latest U.S. census data.”

(Over)

- (2) The school board districts shall be divided into three groups:
- (i) Group I consists of school board districts I, IV, and VII;
 - (ii) Group II consists of school board districts II, V, and VIII; and
 - (iii) Group III consists of school board districts III, VI, and IX.

(3) (I) THE REDISTRICTING BASED ON THE U.S. CENSUS DATA FOR 2000 SHALL BE PERFORMED IN 2001 IN PREPARATION FOR THE SCHOOL BOARD ELECTION IN 2002.

(II) THE REDISTRICTING PLAN SHALL BE BASED ON NINE SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICTS, WITH ONE MEMBER TO BE ELECTED FROM EACH DISTRICT.

(III) AT THE SAME TIME, AN ALTERNATIVE REDISTRICTING PLAN SHALL ALSO BE PROPOSED BASED ON FIVE SCHOOL BOARD DISTRICTS, WITH ONE MEMBER TO BE ELECTED FROM EACH DISTRICT AND FOUR MEMBERS TO BE ELECTED AT LARGE.

(IV) BOTH THE REDISTRICTING PLAN AND THE ALTERNATIVE REDISTRICTING PLAN SHALL BE PRESENTED TO THE SENATE AND HOUSE DELEGATIONS TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY FROM PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY ON OR BEFORE THE FIRST DAY OF THE 2002 LEGISLATIVE SESSION".

On pages 9 through 12, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 6 on page 9 through line 31 on page 12, inclusive.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 12, in line 32, strike "5." and substitute "2."; in line 33, strike "2002" and substitute "2001"; and in the same line, after the period insert "It shall remain effective for a period of 1 year and 7 months and, at the end of December 31, 2002, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.".
