AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE JOINT RESOLUTION NO. 3

(First Reading File Joint Resolution)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Day” and substitute “Month”; in the same line, strike “of the Armenian Genocide”; in line 3, after “Genocide” insert “and the World War II Holocaust”; in the same line, strike “; and” and substitute “by”; in the same line, strike “April 24” and substitute “the month of April”; and in line 4, strike “Day” and substitute “Month”; and in the same line, strike “of the Armenian Genocide of 1915-1923”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, after line 7, insert:

“WHEREAS, Six million Jewish men, women, and children and millions more Poles, gypsies, homosexuals, individuals with disabilities, Jehovah’s Witnesses, Soviet prisoners of war, and communists, socialists, and other political dissidents were exterminated in Nazi concentration camps and extermination camps from 1939 through 1945; and”;

in line 8, after “people” insert “and the extermination of six million Jews during the World War II Holocaust”; in line 9, in each instance, strike “a”; in the same line, strike “attempt” and substitute “attempts”; in line 10, strike “civilization” and substitute “civilizations”; after line 17, insert:

“WHEREAS, Apologists and anti-Semites throughout the world continue to deny that the Holocaust ever occurred; and”;

and in line 25, before “is” insert “and the World War II Holocaust”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, in line 2, after “domination” insert “, and a reunited Germany is a leader of the free world”; in line 3, after “Armenian-Americans” insert “and survivors of the Holocaust”; in

line 7, strike “April 24” and substitute “the month of April”; in the same line, strike “Day” and substitute “Month”; in line 8, strike “of the Armenian Genocide of 1915-1923”“; in lines 9 and 10, strike “on or about April 24” and substitute “during the month April”; in line 10, after “Genocide” insert “and the World War II Holocaust”; in line 30, after “to” insert “:

(1)”;

and in line 32, after “20001” insert “; and

(2) the United States Holocaust Memorial Museum, Days of Remembrance, 100 Raoul Wallenberg Place, SW, Washington, DC 20024; and the American Jewish Congress, Office for Governmental and Public Affairs, 2027 Massachusetts Avenue, NW, Washington, DC 20036”.
