AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 124

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 6, after “subdivisions” insert “under certain circumstances; requiring certain subdivisions to comply with certain standards, building codes, guidelines, and regulations under certain circumstances”; in line 9, after “repair” insert “or replacement”; in line 11, after the semicolon, insert “authorizing the Secretary of the Environment to adopt regulations for certain purposes;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in line 29, after “REPAIR” insert “OR REPLACEMENT”; and in the same line, strike “PUBLIC” and substitute “PUBLICLY OWNED REAL”.

On page 3, in line 11, after “A” insert “MINIMUM BALANCE OF AT LEAST”; in the same line, strike “BALANCE”; in line 16, after “REPAIR” insert “OR REPLACE”; and in line 17, strike “PUBLIC” and substitute “PUBLICLY OWNED REAL”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 15, after “SUBDIVISIONS” insert “FOR CAPITAL EXPENDITURES”; in the same line, after “SECTION” insert “WHEN FEDERAL FUNDS ARE NOT AVAILABLE”; in line 19, after “FUND” insert “FROM ANY SOURCE OTHER THAN STATE FUNDS”; in line 20, strike “GRANT” and substitute “PROJECT”; and after line 21, insert:

“(3) A SUBDIVISION THAT RECEIVES A GRANT FROM THE FUND FOR THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF PUBLICLY OWNED REAL PROPERTY SHALL COMPLY WITH ALL CURRENT STANDARDS, BUILDING CODES, AND REGULATIONS, INCLUDING ANY APPLICABLE FEDERAL FLOODPLAIN GUIDELINES AND REGULATIONS.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

(Over)

On page 3, after line 24, insert:

“(I) THE SECRETARY, IN CONSULTATION WITH THE DIRECTOR OF THE MARYLAND EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO CARRY OUT THE PROVISIONS OF THIS SECTION.”.
