AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 854

(Third Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “clarifying” in line 6 down through “State;” in line 8; and in line 23, strike “6-313 and”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, in line 22, strike “6-313.”; and strike in their entirety lines 32 and 33, inclusive.

On page 4, in lines 15 and 17, in each instance, strike “OR MARYLAND RULES 2-124 AND 3-124”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 2, strike “TERMS” and substitute “WORDS”; strike in their entirety lines 6 and 7; in line 8, strike “(4)” and substitute “(3)”; and in line 23, strike “AN OFFICIAL CUSTODIAN OR” and substitute “A”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, strike beginning with “A” in line 10 down through “OR” in line 13 and substitute “IF THE CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS IS NOT KNOWN AND CANNOT BE ASCERTAINED AFTER A REASONABLE EFFORT BY A PARTY IN A LEGAL PROCEEDING, THE PARTY MAY REQUEST A COURT TO ISSUE A SUBPOENA FOR THE CUSTODIAN OF PUBLIC RECORDS TO BE SERVED ON”.
