AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 874

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 3, strike “requiring” and substitute “authorizing”; and in line 6, strike “instead of assessing certain points” and substitute “for certain periods under certain circumstances”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 4, in line 20, strike “INSTEAD OF ASSESSING POINTS, ON” and substitute “ON”; in line 21, after “IS” insert “CURRENTLY”; strike beginning with “SHALL” in line 22 down through “EXTENDING” in line 23 and substitute “MAY EXTEND”; in line 24, after “REINSTATEMENT” insert “AND, IF THE DATE IS EXTENDED, SHALL ISSUE TO THE INDIVIDUAL A NOTICE”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 34, strike “180 DAYS” and substitute “THE PERIOD OF TIME SPECIFIED IN PARAGRAPH (4) OF THIS SUBSECTION”.

On page 5, after line 5, insert:

“(4) THE ADMINISTRATION MAY EXTEND THE PERIOD OF LICENSE REVOCATION FOR NOT MORE THAN:

(I) 1 YEAR IF IT IS THE INDIVIDUAL’S FIRST VIOLATION;

(II) 18 MONTHS IF IT IS THE INDIVIDUAL’S SECOND VIOLATION;

OR

(III) 2 YEARS IF IT IS THE INDIVIDUAL’S THIRD OR SUBSEQUENT VIOLATION.”.
