AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 495

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, strike beginning with “certain” in line 3 down through “voters” in line 9 and substitute “an individual who has been convicted of a certain crime to qualify to be a registered voter if the individual has completed the sentence imposed for the conviction, including probation”; and in line 10, strike “rights of certain felons” and substitute “qualifications of individuals”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 21, strike the brackets; and in the same line, strike “SUBSECTIONS (B) AND (C)”.

On page 2, in line 8, strike “1. In connection with a first conviction, has” and substitute “HAS”; in line 9, strike “OR” ; strike in their entirety lines 10 through 13, inclusive; and strike in their entirety lines 16 through 18, inclusive.
