AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 215

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Safety Zones” and substitute “Crosswalks”; in line 4, strike “under certain circumstances” and substitute “in a crosswalk”; in line 6, strike “certain areas” and substitute “a crosswalk”; and strike beginning with “requiring” in line 7 down through “violations” in line 14 and substitute “providing a certain penalty for a violation of this Act”; and after line 20, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments,

Article - Transportation

Section 27-101(c)(21)

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1999 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in lines 26 and 29, in each instance, strike “SAFETY ZONE” and substitute “CROSSWALK”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 4 through 36, inclusive; and after line 36, insert:

“27-101.

(c) Any person who is convicted of a violation of any of the provisions of the following sections of this article is subject to a fine of not more than \$500 or imprisonment for not more than 2 months or both:

(21) As to a pedestrian in a marked crosswalk, § 21-502(a) (“Pedestrians’ right-of-way in crosswalks: In general”) AND § 21-107(B) (“FAILURE TO OBEY ORDER OR DIRECTION OF SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD”);”.
