AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL NO. 1186

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 2, strike “Gasoline” and substitute “Motor Fuel”; strike beginning with “requiring” in line 3 down through “specifications” in line 5 and substitute “requiring the grade designation displayed for motor fuel on certain signs or other means advertising the price of motor fuel at a retail outlet to be the same as the grade designation that is required to be displayed for that motor fuel on the retail dispensing pump as specified by the Comptroller”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike in their entirety lines 9 through 12, inclusive, and substitute:

“(D) IF THE RETAIL PRICE OF MOTOR FUEL IS ADVERTISED ON A SIGN OR BY OTHER MEANS ON THE PREMISES OF AND APPROACHES TO THE RETAIL OUTLET, THE GRADE DESIGNATION DISPLAYED FOR ANY MOTOR FUEL IN THE ADVERTISEMENT SHALL BE THE SAME AS THE GRADE DESIGNATION THAT IS REQUIRED TO BE DISPLAYED FOR THAT MOTOR FUEL ON THE RETAIL DISPENSING PUMP AS SPECIFIED BY THE COMPTROLLER.”.
