#### AMENDMENT NO. 1

In line 5, after "regulations" insert "<u>; authorizing noise inspectors to issue civil citations for</u> <u>certain violations; establishing a maximum civil penalty that may be imposed on violators who are</u> <u>issued certain civil citations; and authorizing a right of appeal under certain circumstances</u>".

#### AMENDMENT NO. 2

In line 15, before "THE" insert "(<u>A</u>)"; in the same line, strike "THREE" and substitute "<u>TWO</u>"; and after line 17, insert:

# "(B) <u>A NOISE INSPECTOR EMPLOYED BY THE DEPARTMENT MAY ISSUE A</u> <u>CIVIL CITATION TO A PERSON FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THIS TITLE OR ANY SOUND</u> <u>LEVEL LIMIT OR NOISE CONTROL REGULATION ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE.</u>

(C) (1) <u>A PERSON WHO VIOLATES THIS TITLE OR A REGULATION</u> ADOPTED UNDER THIS TITLE AND IS ISSUED A CIVIL CITATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B) OF THIS SECTION IS SUBJECT TO A CIVIL PENALTY OF NOT MORE THAN \$500.

## (2) ANY MONEY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION SHALL BE DEPOSITED INTO THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.

(3) ANY PERSON ISSUED WITH A CITATION UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MAY APPEAL THE CITATION TO THE OFFICE OF ADMINISTRATIVE HEARINGS IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 10-205 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE.".
