AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 617

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 7, after “years;” insert “requiring the Board to report to certain committees by a certain date on certain activities and recommendations;”; after line 8, insert:

“BY repealing and reenacting, without amendments,

Article 83A - Department of Business and Economic Development

Section 4-201

Annotated Code of Maryland

(1998 Replacement Volume and 2000 Supplement)”;

and in line 11, strike “4-201, 4-203,” and substitute “4-203”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 18, in each instance, strike the brackets; and in line 20, strike the bracket.

On page 2, in line 13, after “IS” insert “EQUITABLY”; in line 24, after “is” insert “EQUITABLY”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 3, in line 34, after the semicolon insert “AND”; in line 35, strike the semicolon and substitute “AND EACH FISCAL YEAR THEREAFTER.”.

On page 4, strike in their entirety lines 1 through 5, inclusive; after line 11, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Tourism Development Board in the Department of Business and Economic Development shall report by December 1, 2002 to the Senate Finance Committee, the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee,

and the House Economic Matters Committee on: (1) its activities relating to planning, advertising, promotion, assistance, and development of the tourism industry in the State during fiscal years 2001 and 2002; (2) its plan of activities anticipated during fiscal years 2003 through 2007; and (3) its recommendations on the funding level for fiscal 2004 and subsequent fiscal years.”;

and in line 12, strike “2.” and substitute “3.”.
