On page 9, after line 5, insert:

in lines 6 and 10, strike "(III)" and "(IIII)", respectively, and substitute "(IIII)" and "(IV)", respectively; in line 7, strike "FOUR" and substitute "TWO"; and strike in their entirety lines 16 through 18, inclusive.
