AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 208

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in the sponsor line, strike “and Van Hollen” and substitute “Van Hollen, Harris, Jimeno, Mooney, and Sfikas”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 1, in line 6, strike “form” and substitute “format”; and in line 19, after “terms;” insert “requiring the Governor to appropriate certain funding in certain fiscal years to assist local law enforcement agencies to implement certain provisions of this Act;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 2, strike beginning with “A” in line 30 down through “PURPOSES” in line 33 and substitute “A MODEL FORMAT FOR THE EFFICIENT RECORDING OF DATA REQUIRED UNDER SUBSECTION (D) OF THIS SECTION ON AN ELECTRONIC DEVICE, OR BY ANY OTHER MEANS, FOR USE BY A LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY”.

On page 3, in line 23, strike “FORM” and substitute “FORMAT”; and in line 24, after “DEVELOPED” insert “BY THE LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCY”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 5, after line 31, insert:

“SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That in order to assist local government law enforcement agencies to implement the data collection and reporting provisions of this Act, the Governor shall:

(1) provide for a deficiency appropriation in the State budget for fiscal year 2002;  
and

(2) appropriate moneys in the State budget for fiscal years 2003 through 2006.”;

and in lines 32 and 36, strike “2.” and “3.”, respectively, and substitute “3.” and “4.”, respectively.
