AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 368

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, at the top of the page, insert “EMERGENCY BILL”; and in line 6, after the second semicolon insert “providing for the termination of this Act; making this Act an emergency measure;”.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, strike beginning with “application” in line 7 down through “after” in line 8 and substitute “individual who was injured on or before”; in line 8, strike “1990” and substitute “1992”; and strike in their entirety lines 9 and 10 and substitute:

“SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act is an emergency measure, is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health and safety, has been passed by a ye and nay vote supported by three-fifths of all the members elected to each of the two Houses of the General Assembly, and shall take effect from the date it is enacted. It shall remain effective through December 31, 2001 and, at the end of December 31, 2001, with no further action required by the General Assembly, this Act shall be abrogated and of no further force and effect.”.
