### AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 3, after line 2, insert:

### "18-2206.

- (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, each recipient of a Maryland teacher scholarship may renew the award three times if the recipient:
  - (1) Continues to be a resident of the State;
- (2) Continues to be a full-time student OR PART-TIME GRADUATE STUDENT at an eligible institution [and takes at least 12 semester hours of courses each semester or its equivalent] as determined by the Administration;
- (3) Has achieved a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 scale and maintains this minimum cumulative grade point average throughout the remainder of this award, or failing to do so, provides evidence of extenuating circumstances;
- (4) <u>In the judgment of the institution, is making satisfactory progress toward a degree; and</u>
  - (5) Maintains the standards of the institution.
