AMENDMENTS TO SENATE BILL NO. 289

(First Reading File Bill)

AMENDMENT NO. 1

On page 1, in line 4, after "Council;" insert "authorizing the Advisory Council to consult with certain individuals or organization representatives;"; and strike beginning with "requiring" in line 7 down through "regulations;" in line 8.

AMENDMENT NO. 2

On page 2, in lines 10 and 11, in each instance, strike "24" and substitute "13"; in line 16, in each instance, strike "22" and substitute "11"; and in line 18, strike "AARP" and substitute "DEPARTMENT OF HEALTH AND MENTAL HYGIENE".

On pages 2 and 3, strike in their entirety the lines beginning with line 21 on page 2 through line 27 on page 3, inclusive, and substitute:

- 3. ONE SHALL BE AN ANESTHESIOLOGIST;
- 4. ONE SHALL BE A CERTIFIED REGISTERED NURSE
ANESTHETIST;
- 5. ONE SHALL BE A CONSUMER;
- 6. ONE SHALL BE A DENTIST;
- 7. ONE SHALL BE AN ETHICIST;
- 8. ONE SHALL BE A GERIATRICIAN;
- 9. ONE SHALL BE A PEDIATRICIAN;

(Over)

10. ONE SHALL BE A PHARMACIST; AND

11. ONE SHALL BE A REGISTERED NURSE WITH EXPERTISE IN HOSPICE, ONCOLOGY, OR PAIN MANAGEMENT.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 3

On page 4, in line 7, before “THE” insert “(1)”; and after line 8, insert:

“(2) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL PUBLISH NOTIFICATION OF THE MEETINGS.”.

AMENDMENT NO. 4

On page 4, after line 31, insert:

“(B) IN ACHIEVING ITS PURPOSE, THE ADVISORY COUNCIL MAY, AS APPROPRIATE, CONSULT WITH THE FOLLOWING INDIVIDUALS OR ORGANIZATION REPRESENTATIVES:

(1) THE AARP;

(2) AN ACUPUNCTURIST;

and in line 32, strike “(B)” and substitute “(C)”.

AMENDMENT NO. 5

On page 5, in line 11, strike “(A)”; in the same line, after “FACILITY” insert “, AS DEFINED IN § 19-114 OF THIS TITLE.”; and strike beginning with “(B)” in line 19 down through

“ASSOCIATION.” in line 28.
