AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 3 of this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001, contingent on the taking effect of Chapter (S.B. 659/H.B. 766) of the Acts of the General Assembly of 2001, and if Chapter does not become effective, Section 3 of this Act shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by the General Assembly.

SECTION 6. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in Section 5 of this Act, this Act shall take effect July 1, 2001."
