- 12 WHEREAS, There is a need for a comprehensive program to coordinate and
- 13 evaluate existing programs for women's health care; and
- 14 WHEREAS, There is a need for a comprehensive plan to expand existing
- 15 programs for women's health care or create new ones; and
- WHEREAS, There is a need for a clearinghouse for information on women's
- 17 health care; and
- 18 WHEREAS, There is a need for a comprehensive study on access by women to
- 19 health care in this State; and
- WHEREAS, The State needs a comprehensive study of the availability and
- 21 utilization of preventive health care for women; and
