15 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "POW/MIA FLAG" MEANS THE POW/MIA FLAG OF THE
16 NATIONAL LEAGUE OF FAMILIES OF AMERICAN PRISONERS AND MISSING IN
17 SOUTHEAST ASIA.

18 (B) EACH YEAR, THE POW/MIA FLAG SHALL BE FLOWN FROM THE STATE 19 HOUSE ON:

20 (1) MAY 30, FOR MEMORIAL DAY;

21 (2) THE DAY THAT THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS DESIGNATES FOR 22 THE OBSERVANCE OF MEMORIAL DAY IF OTHER THAN MAY 30;

UNLESS THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS DESIGNATES ANOTHER DAY FOR THE

THAT ARE CLOSEST TO THE DAY DESIGNATED BY THE UNITED STATES CONGRESS;
