- 9 (2) THE TERMS OF MEMBERS ARE STAGGERED AS REQUIRED BY THE 10 TERMS PROVIDED FOR MEMBERS OF THE COUNCIL ON OCTOBER 1, 2001.
- 11 (3) AT THE END OF A TERM, A MEMBER CONTINUES TO SERVE UNTIL A 12 SUCCESSOR IS APPOINTED AND QUALIFIES.
