2 POW/MIA Flag - Rest Areas, Welcome Centers, and Exhibit Centers

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that a certain POW/MIA flag be flown year round at
- 4 certain rest areas, welcome centers, and exhibit centers; defining a certain term;
- 5 and generally relating to the POW/MIA flag and rest areas, welcome centers,

- WHEREAS, History has been shaped by the brave men and women in the
- 14 United States Armed Forces who answered the call to America's highest duty; and
- 15 WHEREAS, While we honor our veterans for their strength, service, and
- 16 sacrifice, it is equally important to remember those who are missing in action and
- 17 remain unaccounted for; and
- WHEREAS, There are still thousands of American military personnel whose
- 19 whereabouts are unknown; and
- WHEREAS, Families of these courageous patriots deserve to know that this
- 21 State has not forgotten their outstanding contributions; and
- WHEREAS, Each year people in this State and across the country join together
- 23 in remembrance of these missing individuals and to reaffirm our commitment to
- 24 account for all our POW's and MIA's; now, therefore,
- 25 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 26 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

- 3 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "POW/MIA FLAG" MEANS THE POW/MIA FLAG OF THE
- 4 NATIONAL LEAGUE OF FAMILIES OF AMERICAN PRISONERS AND MISSING IN
- 5 SOUTHEAST ASIA.
- 6 (B) THE POW/MIA FLAG SHALL BE FLOWN YEAR ROUND AT EACH REST AREA,
- 7 WELCOME CENTER, AND EXHIBIT CENTER WITHIN INTERSTATE AND STATE
- 8 HIGHWAY RIGHTS-OF-WAY.
- 9 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 10 October 1, 2001.
