1 AN ACT concerning

2 Fire Safety - Smoke Detectors - Residential Dwelling Units

- 3 FOR the purpose of requiring that smoke detectors of a certain type be used in a
- 4 residential dwelling unit that is sold or rented or in which renovations requiring
- 5 a building permit or electrical permit are performed; making this Act applicable
- 6 to smoke detectors powered in a certain way; providing for the application of this
- Act; and generally relating to smoke detectors.

13 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

14 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

15 Article 38A - Fires and Investigations

16 12A.

- 17 (p) A smoke detector required under this section shall be of a type that
- 18 operates both by battery and on an alternating current (AC) primary source of electric
- 19 power if:
- 20 (1) [the] THE smoke detector is installed in a new residential dwelling
- 21 unit:
- 22 [(1)] (I) Containing alternating current (AC) electrical service;
- 23 [(2)] (II) Designed to be occupied by 1 or more families; and
- 24 [(3)] (III) For which a building permit is issued for new construction on or
- 25 after July 1, 1990; OR

1	(2) THE SMOKE DETECTOR CURRENTLY OPERATES ON AN
2	ALTERNATING CURRENT (AC) PRIMARY SOURCE OF ELECTRIC POWER AND IS
3	LOCATED IN A RESIDENTIAL DWELLING UNIT:

- 4 (I) THAT IS SOLD OR RENTED; OR
- 5 (II) IN WHICH RENOVATIONS REQUIRING A BUILDING PERMIT OR 6 ELECTRICAL PERMIT ARE PERFORMED.
- 7 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall be
- 8 construed only prospectively and may not be applied or interpreted to have any effect
- 9 on or application to any smoke detector located in a residential dwelling unit that is
- 10 sold or rented before the effective date of this Act or in which renovations requiring a
- 11 building permit or electrical permit are begun before the effective date of this Act.
- 12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 13 October 1, 2001.
