- 17 (y) (1) "Local official", subject to § 15-807 of this title, means an official,
- 18 officer, or employee of a county or municipal corporation that the governing body of
- 19 the county or municipal corporation determines is subject to Subtitle 8, Part I of this
- 20 title.
- 21 (2) "Local official", subject to § 15-807 of this title, includes each member
- 22 and employee of a board of license commissioners that the applicable governing body
- 23 determines is subject to Subtitle 8, Part I of this title.
- 24 (3) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN ITEM (II) OF THIS PARAGRAPH, "LOCAL
- 25 OFFICIAL" INCLUDES DEPUTY SHERIFFS, DEPUTY AND ASSISTANT STATE'S
- 26 ATTORNEYS, AND ALL OTHER EMPLOYEES OF THE OFFICE OF THE SHERIFF AND THE
- 27 OFFICE OF THE STATE'S ATTORNEY IN EACH COUNTY.
