- 17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

- TITLE 9B. HOME INSPECTORS. 20
- 21 9B-101.
- 22 IN THIS TITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS INDICATED. (A)
- 23 "HOME INSPECTION" MEANS A WRITTEN EVALUATION OF ONE OR MORE
- 24 OF THE COMPONENTS OF AN EXISTING RESIDENTIAL BUILDING, INCLUDING THE
- 25 HEATING SYSTEM, COOLING SYSTEM, PLUMBING SYSTEM, ELECTRICAL SYSTEM,
- 26 STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS, FOUNDATION, ROOF, MASONRY STRUCTURE, EXTERIOR
- 27 AND INTERIOR COMPONENTS, OR ANY OTHER RELATED RESIDENTIAL HOUSING
- 28 COMPONENT.

- 1 (C) "HOME INSPECTOR" MEANS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO ENGAGES IN THE 2 BUSINESS OF PERFORMING HOME INSPECTIONS FOR COMPENSATION.

- 4 AN INDIVIDUAL SHALL BE REGISTERED BY THE DEPARTMENT BEFORE THE
- 5 INDIVIDUAL MAY ENGAGE IN THE BUSINESS OF PERFORMING HOME INSPECTIONS

- 8 (A) AN APPLICANT FOR REGISTRATION AS A HOME INSPECTOR SHALL:
- 9 (1) SUBMIT TO THE DEPARTMENT THE APPLICANT'S NAME, BUSINESS 10 ADDRESS, AND BUSINESS TELEPHONE NUMBER; AND
- 11 (2) PAY TO THE DEPARTMENT A REGISTRATION FEE SET BY THE 12 DEPARTMENT NOT TO EXCEED \$10.
- 13 (B) EACH REGISTERED HOME INSPECTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE DEPARTMENT
- 14 OF ANY CHANGES TO THE INFORMATION SUBMITTED UNDER SUBSECTION (A) OF
- 15 THIS SECTION.

- 17 (A) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL MAINTAIN A LIST OF THE NAMES AND
- 18 BUSINESS ADDRESSES OF ALL HOME INSPECTORS REGISTERED UNDER THIS TITLE.
- 19 (B) THE DEPARTMENT MAY RELEASE THE LIST OF REGISTERED HOME
- 20 INSPECTORS TO THE PUBLIC.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 22 October 1, 2001.
