Except as provided in paragraph (3) of this subsection, a Baltimore 16 17 City school police officer has all the powers of a law enforcement officer in the State. 18 A Baltimore City school police officer may act in an official 19 capacity only on the premises of schools and any other property used for educational 20 purposes owned, leased, or operated by, or under the control of the New Baltimore 21 City Board of School Commissioners.
