BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 14 15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows: 16 **Article - Agriculture** 17 2-509. 18 Regulations and criteria developed by the Foundation relating to land 19 which may be included in an agricultural district shall provide that: [Land] SUBJECT TO ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, LAND shall meet 20 (1) 21 productivity, acreage, and locational criteria determined by the Foundation to be 22 necessary for the continuation of farming; AS LONG AS ALL OTHER CRITERIA ARE MET, LAND IN THE 23 24 FOLLOWING COUNTIES THAT IS AT LEAST 50 ACRES IN SIZE SHALL QUALIFY FOR 25 INCLUSION IN AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT: 26 (I) ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY; 27 (II)CALVERT COUNTY;
