1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Maryland Agricultural Land Preservation Program - Inclusion of Smaller**
3 **Farms ~~in Certain Counties~~**

4 FOR the purpose of requiring regulations and criteria developed by the Maryland
5 Agricultural Land Preservation Foundation to provide that farmland ~~in certain~~
6 ~~counties~~ that is at least a certain number of acres in size shall qualify for
7 inclusion in an agricultural district; and generally relating to the Maryland
8 Agricultural Land Preservation Program.

14 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
15 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 **Article - Agriculture**

17 2-509.

18 (c) Regulations and criteria developed by the Foundation relating to land
19 which may be included in an agricultural district shall provide that:

20 (1) [Land] SUBJECT TO ITEM (2) OF THIS SUBSECTION, LAND shall meet
21 productivity, acreage, and locational criteria determined by the Foundation to be
22 necessary for the continuation of farming;

1 (2) AS LONG AS ALL OTHER CRITERIA ARE MET, LAND ~~IN THE~~
2 ~~FOLLOWING COUNTIES~~ THAT IS AT LEAST 50 ACRES IN SIZE SHALL QUALIFY FOR
3 INCLUSION IN AN AGRICULTURAL DISTRICT:

4 (I) ~~ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY;~~

5 (II) ~~CALVERT COUNTY;~~

6 (III) ~~CHARLES COUNTY;~~

7 (IV) ~~PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY; AND~~

8 (V) ~~ST. MARY'S COUNTY;~~

9 [(2)] (3) The Foundation shall attempt to preserve the minimum
10 number of acres in a given district which may reasonably be expected to promote the
11 continued availability of agricultural suppliers and markets for agricultural goods;

12 [(3)] (4) Land within the boundaries of a 10-year water and sewer
13 service district may be included in an agricultural district only if that land is
14 outstanding in productivity and is of significant size; and

15 [(4)] (5) Land may be included in an agricultural district only if the
16 county regulations governing the land permit the activities listed under § 2-513(a) of
17 this subtitle.

18 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take
19 effect October 1, 2001.
