- 18 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 19 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 20 Article State Personnel and Pensions

- 22 (A) IN THIS SECTION, "COUNCIL" MEANS THE TRI-COUNTY COUNCIL FOR
- 23 SOUTHERN MARYLAND.
- 24 (B) AN EMPLOYEE OF THE COUNCIL MAY ENROLL AND PARTICIPATE IN THE
- 25 HEALTH INSURANCE BENEFIT OPTIONS ESTABLISHED UNDER THE PROGRAM WITH
- 26 THE APPROVAL OF THE COUNCIL.
- 27 (C) THE COUNCIL SHALL:

- 1 (1) PAY TO THE STATE THE TOTAL COSTS RESULTING FROM THE 2 PARTICIPATION OF ITS EMPLOYEES IN THE PROGRAM; AND
- 3 (2) DETERMINE THE EXTENT TO WHICH THE COUNCIL WILL SUBSIDIZE 4 PARTICIPATION OF ITS EMPLOYEES IN THE PROGRAM.
- 5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 6 July 1, 2001.
