1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Insurance - Risk Based Capital Standards for Insurers - Exemption**

3 FOR the purpose of authorizing the Commissioner to exempt certain insurers from
4 the application of certain provisions of the risk based capital standards for
5 certain insurers; and generally relating to exemptions from the risk based
6 capital standards for certain insurers.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Insurance

2 4-311.

3 (c) The Commissioner may exempt from the application of this Act any
4 domestic property and casualty insurer that:

- 5 (1) writes direct business only in the State;
- 6 (2) writes direct annual premiums of \$2,000,000 or less; and
- 7 (3) assumes no reinsurance in excess of 5% of direct premiums written.

8 (D) THE COMMISSIONER MAY EXEMPT FROM THE APPLICATION OF THIS ACT
9 ANY DOMESTIC HEALTH INSURER THAT:

- 10 (1) (I) WRITES DIRECT BUSINESS ONLY IN THE STATE;
- 11 (II) ASSUMES NO REINSURANCE IN EXCESS OF 5% OF DIRECT
12 PREMIUMS WRITTEN; AND
- 13 (III) WRITES DIRECT ANNUAL PREMIUMS FOR COMPREHENSIVE
14 MEDICAL BUSINESS OF \$2,000,000 OR LESS; OR
- 15 (2) COVERS LESS THAN 2,000 LIVES IF THE HEALTH INSURER IS:
- 16 (I) A NONPROFIT HEALTH SERVICE PLAN THAT PROVIDES
17 COVERAGE SOLELY FOR DENTAL SERVICES; OR
- 18 (II) A DENTAL PLAN ORGANIZATION.

19 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
20 July 1, 2001.
