- 17 (A) EXCEPT FOR AN APPLICANT AS PROVIDED IN SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS
- 18 SECTION, A FINAL DECISION BY THE DEPARTMENT ON THE ISSUANCE, RENEWAL, OR
- 19 REVISION OF AN OPERATING PERMIT ISSUED PURSUANT TO TITLE V OF THE
- 20 FEDERAL CLEAN AIR ACT AMENDMENTS OF 1990 IS SUBJECT TO JUDICIAL REVIEW BY

- 22 (1) WOULD HAVE STANDING TO SUE WITH RESPECT TO THE MATTER
- 23 UNDER APPLICABLE FEDERAL LAW; AND

- 2 THE DEPARTMENT AND LIMITED TO OBJECTIONS RAISED DURING THE PUBLIC
- 3 COMMENT PERIOD UNLESS THE PETITIONER DEMONSTRATES:
- 4 (1) THAT IT WAS IMPRACTICABLE TO RAISE THE OBJECTIONS DURING 5 THE COMMENT PERIOD; OR
- 6 (2) THAT GROUNDS FOR THE OBJECTIONS AROSE AFTER THE COMMENT 7 PERIOD.
- 8 (C) AN APPLICANT FOR AN AIR QUALITY OPERATING PERMIT MAY SEEK
- 9 JUDICIAL REVIEW IN ACCORDANCE WITH TITLE 10, SUBTITLE 2 OF THE STATE
