14 15 16 17 18 19	(1) The Board of Public Works may borrow money and incur indebtedness on behalf of the State of Maryland through a State loan to be known as the Montgomery County - Site for Electronic Media, Art, and Technology Loan of 2001 in a total principal amount equal to the lesser of (i) \$750,000 \$300,000 or (ii) the amount of the matching fund provided in accordance with Section 1(5) below. This loan shall be evidenced by the issuance, sale, and delivery of State general obligation bonds authorized by a resolution of the Board of Public Works and issued, sold, and delivered in accordance with § 8-117 through 8-124 of the State Finance and Procurement Article and Article 31, § 22 of the Code.
