12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, 7 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or 8 apply to the salary or compensation of the Harford County Election Judges in office 9 on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the salary or 10 compensation of the Harford County Election Judges shall take effect at the 11 beginning of the next following term of office.

12 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 13 July 1, 2001.
