A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County - Alcoholic Beverages - Stadium Beer and Light Wine**
3 **License**

4 FOR the purpose of creating in Harford County a stadium beer and light wine on-sale
5 alcoholic beverages license; establishing that the license may be issued to
6 certain persons for certain use; establishing the hours and days for sale, terms
7 and conditions, and annual fee for the license; and generally relating to a
8 stadium beer and light wine alcoholic beverages license in Harford County.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

21 **Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages**

22 8-213.1.

23 (A) THIS SECTION APPLIES ONLY IN HARFORD COUNTY.

24 (B) THERE IS A STADIUM BEER AND LIGHT WINE ON-SALE LICENSE IN
25 HARFORD COUNTY.

1 (C) THE LIQUOR CONTROL BOARD MAY ISSUE A STADIUM BEER AND LIGHT
2 WINE ON-SALE LICENSE TO THE OWNER OR LESSEE OF A PROFESSIONAL BASEBALL
3 STADIUM FOR USE ON THE STADIUM PREMISES.

4 (D) A STADIUM BEER AND LIGHT WINE ON-SALE LICENSE AUTHORIZES THE
5 HOLDER TO SELL BEER AND, IF SOLD WITH A MEAL, LIGHT WINE ON THE LICENSED
6 PREMISES:

7 (1) FOR CONSUMPTION ONLY ON THE LICENSED PREMISES;

8 (2) IN A PLASTIC, STYROFOAM, OR PAPER CONTAINER, EXCEPT THAT A
9 GLASS CONTAINER MAY BE USED IN AN ENCLOSED DINING AREA IN WHICH PATRONS
10 ARE SEATED;

11 (3) TO A PERSON PRESENT:

12 (I) AT A BASEBALL GAME IN WHICH THE TEAM OF THE LICENSEE
13 OR LESSEE IS PLAYING; OR

14 (II) AT ANOTHER EVENT THAT IS HELD AT THE STADIUM; AND

15 (4) DURING THE HOURS AND DAYS FOR SALE SPECIFIED IN § 11-513 OF
16 THIS ARTICLE.

17 (E) THE ANNUAL LICENSE FEE IS \$5,000.

18 (F) EXCEPT FOR A WHOLESALER OF BEER OR WINE WHO IS CONDUCTING
19 BUSINESS WITH THE LICENSEE UNDER THIS SECTION, A LICENSEE MAY NOT ALLOW
20 A PERSON TO CARRY ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ONTO OR FROM THE LICENSED
21 PREMISES.

22 11-513.

23 (a) The provisions of this section apply in Harford County only.

24 (b) (1) A licensee may sell, offer for sale or dispense alcoholic beverages or
25 light wine:

26 (i) On Monday through Sunday; and

27 (ii) Only between 8 a.m. and 2 a.m. the following morning.

28 (2) A Class B-4 (seafood restaurant) licensee may offer to sell beer and
29 wine:

30 (i) On Mondays through Saturdays from 5:30 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.;

31 and

32 (ii) On Sundays from 12 noon to 11:00 p.m.

1 (3) (I) EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN SUBPARAGRAPH (II) OF THIS
2 PARAGRAPH, A STADIUM BEER AND LIGHT WINE LICENSEE UNDER § 8-213.1 OF THIS
3 ARTICLE MAY SELL OR OFFER TO SELL BEER OR LIGHT WINE:

4 1. MONDAY THROUGH SATURDAY FROM 12 NOON TO 9 P.M.;
5 AND

6 2. SUNDAY FROM 1 P.M. TO 5 P.M.

7 (II) DURING A BASEBALL GAME ONLY, A LICENSEE MAY NOT SELL
8 ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES:

9 1. AFTER THE BEGINNING OF THE EIGHTH INNING; OR

10 2. DURING A DOUBLEHEADER GAME, AFTER THE
11 BEGINNING OF THE SIXTH INNING OF THE SECOND GAME.

12 (c) A licensee may not:

13 (1) Allow alcoholic beverages or light wine to be consumed on his
14 premises after 2:15 a.m. or before 8:00 a.m. the same morning; or

15 (2) Allow alcoholic beverages glasses, bottles, or containers to remain on
16 tables or serving counters after 2:30 a.m.

17 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
18 July 1, 2001.
