19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

1 Article 2B - Alcoholic Beverages 2 6-704. (a) (1) This section applies only in Harford County. 3 The annual license fee is \$750, which shall be paid to the Board 4 (2) 5 before the license is issued and which shall be distributed as provided. In this section, "caterer" means an establishment that: 6 (3)7 (I) fowns OWNS or leases 1 or more banquet rooms suitable for public gatherings, with food preparation facilities on the premises, 1; AND (which) PROVIDES FOOD AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ITS 9 (II)10 OWN EVENTS OR contracts to provide food and alcoholic beverages to sponsors of 11 public or private events. 12 A Class H beer, wine and liquor license may be issued upon the (b) (1) 13 approval of the Liquor Control Board and authorizes the owner or operator of a 14 catering establishment to keep for sale and sell all alcoholic beverages at retail at the 15 premises described therein for consumption on the premises during the catered event. Notwithstanding the provisions of § 12-107 of this article or any 16 17 other contrary provision of this article, a caterer licensed under this section also may contract with patrons to permit them to bring personal alcoholic beverages onto the premises of the caterer for consumption at catered events. 20 A caterer licensed under this section may: (3) PROVIDE FOOD AND ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR ITS OWN 21 22 EVENTS ON ITS OWN PREMISES; OR 23 fcontract CONTRACT to provide alcoholic beverages at events (II)24 held off the premises, provided that: 25 $\{(i)\}$ 1. The caterer contracts to provide food, as well as alcoholic 26 beverages, for consumption at the catered event; and 27 2. The event is held in Harford County. {(ii)} A CATERER LICENSED UNDER THIS SECTION MAY PROVIDE FOOD 28 29 AND KEEP AND SELL AT RETAIL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, FOR CONSUMPTION ONLY 30 ON THE PREMISES OF THE CATERER, AT A SELF-SPONSORED EVENT HELD ONCE 31 DURING A CALENDAR YEAR ON A DAY SELECTED BY THE CATERER. SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect 32 33 October 1, 2001.
