- 1 (B) THE COMMISSION MAY IMPOSE A CIVIL PENALTY NOT EXCEEDING \$10,000
- 2 AGAINST A PERSON WHO VIOLATES A PROVISION OF THIS ARTICLE, OR AN
- 3 EFFECTIVE AND OUTSTANDING DIRECTION, RULING, ORDER, RULE, OR REGULATION
- 4 OF THE COMMISSION.
- 5 (C) (1) A CIVIL PENALTY MAY BE IMPOSED IN ADDITION TO ANY OTHER 6 PENALTY AUTHORIZED BY THIS ARTICLE.
- 7 (2) EACH VIOLATION IS A SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- 8 (3) EACH DAY OR PART OF A DAY THE VIOLATION CONTINUES IS A 9 SEPARATE OFFENSE.
- 10 (D) THE COMMISSION SHALL DETERMINE THE AMOUNT OF ANY CIVIL 11 PENALTY AFTER CONSIDERING:
- 12 (1) THE NUMBER OF PREVIOUS VIOLATIONS OF ANY PROVISION OF THIS 13 ARTICLE;
- 14 (2) THE GRAVITY OF THE CURRENT VIOLATION;
- 15 (3) THE GOOD FAITH EFFORTS OF THE VIOLATOR IN ATTEMPTING TO 16 ACHIEVE COMPLIANCE AFTER NOTIFICATION OF THE VIOLATION; AND
- 17 (4) ANY OTHER MATTER THAT THE COMMISSION CONSIDERS 18 APPROPRIATE AND RELEVANT.
- 19 (E) A CIVIL PENALTY COLLECTED UNDER THIS SECTION SHALL BE PAID INTO 20 THE GENERAL FUND OF THE STATE.
- 21 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take 22 effect October 1, 2001.
