- 3 FOR the purpose of creating an Office of People's Environmental Counsel; requiring
- 4 the Governor to appoint the People's Environmental Counsel; establishing
- 5 certain duties and powers for the People's Environmental Counsel and the
- 6 Office of People's Environmental Counsel; requiring the State budget to provide
- 7 certain funding for the Office of People's Environmental Counsel; and generally

- 15 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 16 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 17 Article Environment
- 18 SUBTITLE 7. OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL.
- 19 1-701.
- 20 (A) WITH THE ADVICE AND CONSENT OF THE SENATE, THE GOVERNOR SHALL
- 21 APPOINT THE PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL.
- 22 (B) THE PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL SHALL SERVE AT THE
- 23 PLEASURE OF THE GOVERNOR.
- 24 (C) THE PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL SHALL AT ALL TIMES BE
- 25 ADMITTED TO PRACTICE LAW IN THE STATE WHILE HOLDING THE POSITION OF
- 26 PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL.

- 1 (D) BEFORE TAKING OFFICE, THE PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL
- 2 SHALL TAKE THE OATH REQUIRED BY ARTICLE I, § 9 OF THE MARYLAND
- 3 CONSTITUTION.
- 4 (E) THE PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL SHALL DEVOTE FULL TIME TO
- 5 THE DUTIES OF THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL.
- 6 (F) THE PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL IS ENTITLED TO A SALARY AS 7 PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET.

- 9 (A) THERE IS AN OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL
- 10 ADMINISTERED AND OPERATED BY THE PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL.
- 11 (B) THE STATE BUDGET SHALL PROVIDE SUFFICIENT MONEY FOR THE
- 12 OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL TO HIRE NECESSARY STAFF TO
- 13 MEET THE REQUIREMENTS OF THIS SUBTITLE.

- 15 (A) IF THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL DETERMINES
- 16 THAT THE INTERESTS OF THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE ARE AFFECTED, THE OFFICE
- 17 OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL MAY APPEAR BEFORE THE DEPARTMENT
- 18 AND ANY COURTS ON BEHALF OF THE CITIZENS OF THE STATE IN ANY MATTER OR
- 19 PROCEEDING OVER WHICH THE DEPARTMENT HAS PRIMARY ENFORCEMENT AND
- 20 PERMITTING RESPONSIBILITY, INCLUDING THE ISSUANCE OF AND COMPLIANCE
- 21 WITH PERMITS AND LICENSES AND THE ENFORCEMENT OF AND COMPLIANCE WITH
- 22 REGULATIONS.
- 23 (B) AS THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL CONSIDERS
- 24 NECESSARY, THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL:
- 25 (1) SHALL INVESTIGATE COMPLAINTS BY CITIZENS CONCERNING THE
- 26 DEPARTMENT'S ENFORCEMENT OF LAWS FOR WHICH THE DEPARTMENT HAS
- 27 PRIMARY ENFORCEMENT RESPONSIBILITY:
- 28 (2) MAY INITIATE ADMINISTRATIVE OR LEGAL PROCEEDINGS WITH THE
- 29 DEPARTMENT OR ANY COURTS TO RESOLVE THE CITIZEN'S COMPLAINTS; AND
- 30 (3) MAY CONDUCT INVESTIGATIONS AND REQUEST THE DEPARTMENT
- 31 TO INITIATE ADMINISTRATIVE OR LEGAL PROCEEDINGS AS THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S
- 32 ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL DETERMINES TO BE NECESSARY TO PROTECT THE
- 33 INTERESTS OF CITIZENS.
- 34 1-704.
- 35 (A) EXCEPT AS OTHERWISE PROVIDED IN THIS ARTICLE AND CONSISTENT
- 36 WITH ANY APPLICABLE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION ACT, THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S
- 37 ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL SHALL HAVE FULL ACCESS TO THE DEPARTMENT'S

- 1 RECORDS AND SHALL HAVE THE BENEFIT OF ALL OTHER FACILITIES OR
- 2 INFORMATION OF THE DEPARTMENT.
- 3 (B) IF THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL CONSIDERS
- 4 THAT THE LEGISLATION WOULD AFFECT THE INTERESTS OF THE CITIZENS OF THIS
- 5 STATE, THE OFFICE OF PEOPLE'S ENVIRONMENTAL COUNSEL MAY RECOMMEND TO
- 6 THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY LEGISLATION ON ANY MATTER RELATED TO THE
- 7 DEPARTMENT'S JURISDICTION.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
- 9 October 1, 2001.
