- 19 (A) ON THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE STATE SUPERINTENDENT, THE
- 20 DEPARTMENT SHALL ADOPT PROCEDURES FOR THE SELECTION AND PURCHASE OF
- 21 GRAPHING CALCULATORS (WITH FEATURES CONSISTENT WITH THE FEATURES OF
- 22 THE TI-83+ CALCULATOR).
- 23 (B) THE DEPARTMENT SHALL DISTRIBUTE THE GRAPHING CALCULATORS TO
- 24 EACH COUNTY IN THE FOLLOWING QUANTITIES:
