17 (a) The Administration shall annually select eligible students and offer a
18 scholarship to each student selected to be used at an eligible institution of their
19 choice.
(b) A recipient of the Maryland Teacher Scholarship shall:

10 (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) of this section, each recipient of a 11 Maryland teacher scholarship may renew the award three times if the recipient:

12 (1) Continues to be a resident of the State;
13 (2) Continues to be a full-time student OR PART-TIME GRADUATE
14 STUDENT at an eligible institution [and takes at least 12 semester hours of courses 15 each semester or its equivalent] as determined by the Administration;

16 (3) Has achieved a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.0 on a 4.0 17 scale and maintains this minimum cumulative grade point average throughout the
18 remainder of this award, or failing to do so, provides evidence of extenuating
19 circumstances;
20 (4) In the judgment of the institution, is making satisfactory progress

24 an associate degree program as permitted in this subtitle may renew the award two
25 times if the recipient is enrolled in an associate degree program that, as determined

27 (2) Each recipient of the Maryland teacher scholarship may renew the
28 annual award four times if the recipient is enrolled in a course of study that, as
29 determined by the institution, requires 5 years to complete.
