1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Transportation Service - Elderly and Individuals with Disabilities - Criteria**

3 FOR the purpose of requiring that the criteria developed by the Secretary of
4 Transportation with respect to the distribution of certain funds to a county for
5 transportation service to elderly and handicapped persons shall include a
6 provision that allows the funds to be made available to a county with exemplary
7 performance records as to the provision of transportation service to elderly and
8 handicapped persons in the county.

19 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
20 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Transportation

3 (a) (1) In this section, the following words have the meanings indicated.

4 (2) "County" includes Baltimore City.

5 (3) "Elderly and handicapped person" means any person who, by reason
6 of illness, injury, age, congenital malfunction, or other permanent or temporary
7 incapacity or disability, is unable to use mass transit facilities and services as
8 effectively as a person who is not so affected.9 (4) "Transportation service" means any transportation option or mix of
10 options that may include paratransit or fixed route service, established or employed
11 by a county to accommodate the transportation needs of its elderly and handicapped
12 residents.13 (e) (1) If any of the allocated funds described in subsection (c) of this section
14 are not applied for by the counties within 6 months after the beginning of the fiscal
15 year, the Secretary shall make those funds available to counties pursuant to
16 application procedures and criteria developed by the Secretary, in consultation with
17 the Department of Aging and the Governor's Office for Individuals with Disabilities.
18 The criteria shall provide that:19 (i) Such funds may be made available to counties WITH
20 EXEMPLARY PERFORMANCE RECORDS AS TO THE PROVISION OF TRANSPORTATION
21 SERVICE TO ELDERLY AND HANDICAPPED PERSONS OR TO COUNTIES in which the
22 Secretary determines that additional funds for transportation service to [the] elderly
23 and handicapped PERSONS are most needed; and24 (ii) Local match requirements described in subsection (f) of this
25 section shall apply to all disbursements.26 (2) A written application submitted by a county under this subsection
27 may not be accepted or considered by the Secretary unless the local area agency on
28 aging certifies its approval of the project for the funding for which the application is
29 made.30 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
31 July 1, 2001.
