1 BENEFIT ENHANCEMENT ADDED ON OR AFTER JULY 1, 2001 TO THE LAW 2 ENFORCEMENT OFFICERS' MODIFIED PENSION BENEFIT. 3 26-401. 4 (b) Except as provided in paragraphs (2) and (3) of this subsection, on (1) 5 retirement under this section, a member is entitled to receive a normal service 6 retirement allowance that equals the number of years of the member's creditable 7 service multiplied by 2% of the member's average final compensation. 8 A member's normal service retirement allowance under paragraph 9 (1) of this subsection may not exceed 60% of the member's average final 10 compensation. 11 (3) This paragraph applies only to a member who is not subject to 12 the Law Enforcement Officers' Modified Pension Benefit under Subtitle 2, Part II of 13 this title. 14 On retirement under this paragraph, the member is entitled to (ii) 15 receive a normal service retirement allowance that equals: 2.3% of the member's average final compensation 1. [2%] 17 multiplied by each year of the member's first 30 years of creditable service; and 18 1% of the member's average final compensation multiplied 19 by each year of creditable service in excess of 30 years.
