12 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF 13 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

16 THE DEPARTMENT MAY ADOPT REGULATIONS TO LIMIT OR PROHIBIT THE 17 IMPORTATION, USE, CATCHING, OR POSSESSING OF THE FOLLOWING NONNATIVE 18 CRAB SPECIES, WHICH ARE DETERMINED TO BE HARMFUL TO THE ECOLOGY AND 19 NATURAL RESOURCES OF THE STATE:

GREEN CRAB (CARCINUS MAENAS) OF THE FAMILY PORTUNIDAE;
