1 AN ACT concerning

2 Higher Education - Maryland Teacher Loan and Loan-Forgiveness Program

- 3 FOR the purpose of establishing the Maryland Teacher Loan and Loan-Forgiveness
- 4 Program for certain students; providing for the award of certain loans; setting
- 5 certain eligibility standards; providing for debt forgiveness and loan repayment;
- 6 providing for the renewal of a loan award for certain students under certain
- 7 circumstances; establishing a certain amount for a loan award; providing for
- 8 certain expenses for which a loan award may be used; providing funding for the
- 9 Program; requiring the State Scholarship Administration to publicize the
- availability of Program loan awards; requiring the Maryland Higher Education
- 11 Commission to submit a certain plan by a certain date; providing for a delayed
- effective date for certain provisions of this Act; providing for the termination of
- certain provisions of this Act; defining certain terms; and generally relating to
- the Maryland Teacher Loan and Loan-Forgiveness Program.

- 21 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF
- 22 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:
- 23 Article Education
- 24 SUBTITLE 26. MARYLAND TEACHER LOAN AND LOAN-FORGIVENESS PROGRAM.
- 25 18-2601.
- 26 (A) IN THIS SUBTITLE THE FOLLOWING WORDS HAVE THE MEANINGS
- 27 INDICATED.

- 1 (B) "ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION" MEANS A 4-YEAR OR GRADUATE PUBLIC OR
- 2 PRIVATE INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION IN THE STATE THAT POSSESSES A
- 3 CERTIFICATE OF APPROVAL FROM THE COMMISSION.
- 4 (C) (1) "SERVICE OBLIGATION" MEANS TO TEACH FULL TIME AS A
- 5 CERTIFIED TEACHER IN A MARYLAND PUBLIC ELEMENTARY OR SECONDARY
- 6 SCHOOL.
- 7 (2) "SERVICE OBLIGATION" DOES NOT MEAN EMPLOYMENT AS A
- 8 TEACHING ASSISTANT, VOLUNTEER SERVICE, A PAID FELLOWSHIP, OR AN
- 9 INTERNSHIP.
- 10 18-2602.
- 11 THERE IS A MARYLAND TEACHER LOAN AND LOAN-FORGIVENESS PROGRAM
- 12 THAT AWARDS LOANS UNDER THIS SUBTITLE TO STUDENTS WHO PLEDGE TO WORK
- 13 ON GRADUATION AS PUBLIC ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY SCHOOL TEACHERS IN
- 14 THE STATE FOR 5 CONSECUTIVE YEARS.
- 15 18-2603.
- 16 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION ANNUALLY SHALL SELECT ELIGIBLE LOAN
- 17 APPLICANTS AND OFFER A PROGRAM LOAN AWARD OF \$5,000 TO BE USED AT AN
- 18 ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION.
- 19 (B) A RECIPIENT OF A PROGRAM LOAN AWARD SHALL:
- 20 (1) BE CURRENTLY ENROLLED AT OR ACCEPTED FOR ADMISSION TO AN
- 21 ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION AS A FULL-TIME THIRD-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE,
- 22 FOURTH-YEAR UNDERGRADUATE, OR GRADUATE STUDENT;
- 23 (2) BE PURSUING A COURSE OF STUDY OR PROGRAM IN AN ACADEMIC
- 24 DISCIPLINE LEADING TO A MARYLAND PROFESSIONAL TEACHER'S CERTIFICATE;
- 25 (3) SIGN A LETTER OF INTENT TO PERFORM THE SERVICE OBLIGATION
- 26 ON GRADUATION FOR 5 CONSECUTIVE YEARS:
- 27 (4) ACCEPT ANY OTHER CONDITIONS ATTACHED TO THE AWARD; AND
- 28 (5) SATISFY ANY ADDITIONAL CRITERIA THAT THE COMMISSION MAY
- 29 ESTABLISH.
- 30 (C) A RECIPIENT OF A PROGRAM LOAN MAY NOT HOLD OR BE ELIGIBLE FOR A
- 31 MARYLAND PROFESSIONAL TEACHER'S CERTIFICATE.
- 32 18-2604.
- 33 (A) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL FORGIVE THE PROGRAM LOAN AWARDS OF
- 34 A RECIPIENT IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO ONE-FIFTH OF THE TOTAL LOAN AWARDS
- 35 FOR EACH YEAR THAT THE RECIPIENT FULFILLS THE SERVICE OBLIGATION.

- 1 (B) SUBJECT TO SUBSECTION (C) OF THIS SECTION, THE RECIPIENT OF A
- 2 PROGRAM LOAN SHALL REPAY THE COMMISSION THE FUNDS RECEIVED PLUS
- 3 INTEREST, AT A RATE ESTABLISHED BY THE COMMISSION, CALCULATED FROM THE
- 4 DATE OF THE FIRST PAYMENT OF THE LOAN AWARD UNDER THIS SUBTITLE FOR ANY
- 5 PORTION OF THE LOAN NOT FORGIVEN IF THE RECIPIENT DOES NOT:
- 6 (1) SATISFY THE DEGREE REQUIREMENTS OF THE ELIGIBLE COURSE OF
- 7 STUDY OR PROGRAM OR FULFILL OTHER REQUIREMENTS AS PROVIDED IN THIS
- 8 SUBTITLE;
- 9 (2) PERFORM THE SERVICE OBLIGATION FOR 5 CONSECUTIVE YEARS; OR
- 10 (3) BECOME PROFESSIONALLY CERTIFIED TO TEACH IN THE STATE
- 11 WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED BY THE COMMISSION IN CONSULTATION WITH
- 12 THE DEPARTMENT.
- 13 (C) THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL FORGIVE A RECIPIENT OF A PROGRAM LOAN
- 14 AWARD IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO TWO-FIFTHS OF THE LOAN AWARD IF:
- 15 (1) THE RECIPIENT HAS TAKEN THE TEACHER CERTIFICATION
- 16 EXAMINATION, APPROVED BY THE STATE BOARD, IN 2 CONSECUTIVE YEARS; AND
- 17 (2) THE RECIPIENT FAILS TO PASS THE TEACHER CERTIFICATION
- 18 EXAMINATION WITHIN THE TIME PERIOD SPECIFIED BY THE COMMISSION UNDER
- 19 SUBSECTION (B)(3) OF THIS SECTION.

- 21 THE ANNUAL LOAN AWARD SHALL BE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.
- 22 18-2606.
- 23 A RECIPIENT OF A PROGRAM LOAN AWARD WHO WILL BE A FOURTH-YEAR
- 24 UNDERGRADUATE STUDENT MAY APPLY TO RENEW THE LOAN AWARD IF THE
- 25 RECIPIENT:
- 26 (1) CONTINUES TO BE A FULL-TIME STUDENT AT AN ELIGIBLE
- 27 INSTITUTION AND TAKES AT LEAST 12 SEMESTER HOURS OF COURSES EACH
- 28 SEMESTER OR ITS EQUIVALENT, AS DETERMINED BY THE ADMINISTRATION;
- 29 (2) IN THE JUDGMENT OF THE ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION, IS MAKING
- 30 SATISFACTORY PROGRESS TOWARD A DEGREE; AND
- 31 (3) MAINTAINS THE STANDARDS OF THE ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION.

- 33 A PROGRAM LOAN AWARD MAY BE USED FOR:
- 34 (1) TUITION AND MANDATORY FEES AT AN ELIGIBLE INSTITUTION; AND

- 1 (2) ROOM AND BOARD.

- FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE ANNUAL BUDGET OF 4 THE COMMISSION BY THE GOVERNOR.
- 5 18-2609.
- 6 THE ADMINISTRATION SHALL PUBLICIZE THE AVAILABILITY OF PROGRAM 7 LOAN AWARDS.
- 8 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:
- 9 (a) The Maryland Higher Education Commission shall draft a plan to 10 administer the Maryland Teacher Loan and Loan-Forgiveness Program.
- 11 (b) The plan shall include a 3-year schedule, beginning July 1, 2002, for the
- 12 progressive implementation of the Maryland Teacher Loan and Loan-Forgiveness
- 13 Program.
- 14 (c) The Commission shall submit the plan for the implementation of the
- 15 Maryland Teacher Loan and Loan-Forgiveness Program to the Governor and the
- 16 Legislative Policy Committee of the General Assembly by October 31, 2001.
- 17 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section 1 of this Act shall 18 take effect June 1, 2002.
- 19 SECTION 4. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, except as provided in
- 20 Section 3 of this Act, this Act shall take effect June 1, 2001. Section 2 of this Act shall
- 21 remain effective for a period of 5 months and at the end of October 31, 2001, with no
- 22 further action required by the General Assembly, Section 2 of this Act shall be
- 23 abrogated and of no further force and effect.
