A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ACT concerning

2 **Harford County - State's Attorney - Salary**

3 FOR the purpose of increasing the salary of the State's Attorney for Harford County

4 by certain amounts by certain dates; providing that this Act does not apply to

5 the salary or compensation of the incumbent State's Attorney; and generally

6 relating to the salary of the State's Attorney for Harford County.

17 SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF

18 MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

19 **Article 10 - Legal Officials**

20 40.

21 (m) (1) This subsection applies only in Harford County.

22 (2) (i) The annual salary of the State's Attorney is:

23 1. \$72,500 through June 30, 1998;

24 2. \$74,500 commencing July 1, 1998 through June 30, 2000;

25 3. \$76,500 commencing July 1, 2000;

- 1 4. \$78,500 commencing July 1, 2001; [and]
- 2 5. \$80,320 commencing July 1, 2002[, and thereafter];
- 3 6. \$85,160 COMMENCING IN 2003; AND
- 4 7. \$90,000 COMMENCING IN 2004 AND THEREAFTER.

5 SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III,
6 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or
7 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Harford County in
8 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the
9 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Harford County shall take effect at
10 the beginning of the next following term of office.

11 SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect
12 October 1, 2001.
