AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That, pursuant to Article III, 10 Section 35 of the Constitution of Maryland, this Act may not be construed to extend or 11 apply to the salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Harford County in 12 office on the effective date of this Act, but the provisions of this Act concerning the 13 salary or compensation of the State's Attorney for Harford County shall take effect at 14 the beginning of the next following term of office.
